

## St. Theodore Parish Altar Servers

The Mass is the central action of our parish. The reason our parish exists is to form saints and this is primarily done through the celebration of the Mass. Everything we do as a community, whether that be our school, PSR program, youth ministry, sports, etc. flows from our celebration of the Mass and is designed to lead back to the weekly celebration of the Mass.

As such, altar serving is a function of the parish which requires commitment to serving at the parish Sunday masses. Servers will be scheduled according to their family's Sunday mass preference and a monthly schedule will be sent out. - Must be in the 4th grade or older
- Active member of St. Theodore Parish (or one's home parish, if a student at St. Theodore School)
