From the Pastor

I continue to be edified by how so many of our parishioners are engaging this season of Lent. Seeing so many of our parishioners receiving the Sacrament of Confession, our parishioner's faithful presence at our weekly Stations of the Cross service, the crowd who attended our Lent Family Night, and those attending our Lenten series is a testament to the deep faith of our parish. If you have not done so already, please consider receiving the Sacrament of Confession. Whether it has been one month, 1 year, 10 years, or even 50 years since your last confession, Christ is always waiting to offer us His mercy. If you are unsure how to receive the Sacrament of Confession, simply come into the confessional, let me know, and I will be happy to guide you.

This weekend Deacon Dan announced to the parish that he and his wife Marie would be relocating to Texas in the next couple of months and, as a result, will be leaving our parish. Deacon Dan started here at St. Theodore shortly before I arrived and has faithfully served our parish. Over the past several years, he has assisted me at Mass and preached about once a month, baptized our record number of babies presented for baptism, led our RCIA program, and faithfully ministered in many behind-the-scenes capacities. I am grateful for all the countless ways he has assisted me as the pastor, and I know our parish will certainly miss having him and Marie in our parish family. While Deacon Dan will still be with us until May 21st, we wanted to share this news as soon as it became effective. My thanks go to everyone who has stepped up to help us purchase a new car for the sisters.
